

夏季休業中等の行動に関する大学からの注意喚起です。

(1) レジャー中の事故の防止

今年も、レジャー中の水難事故が既に全国で発生しており、本人のみならず救助に向かった方が犠牲になるケースも見られます。昨年は本学学生が被害に遭う事故も発生しており、より慎重な行動が求められます。

海、川、山などでレジャーを行う機会がある場合には、自然の脅威に対する自覚を持つとともに、慎重な状況判断に努め、自分の身は自分で守りましょう。その場所における情報収集を行い、準備・安全確認をした上で、活動を計画・実施してください。

静岡県遠州の御前崎から愛知県東三河の伊良湖岬までの約 110 kmの遠州灘海岸は、潮の流れが速く、水深が急に深くなるなど危険な場所が多く存在し、ほとんどが遊泳禁止です。波打ち際でも注意が必要です。

(2) 性犯罪等の被害の防止

「人通りが多く明るい道を通る」「深夜の外出は避ける」「常に玄関・ベランダサッシ等には施錠をする」ことを心掛けてください。

不審者に遭遇した場合は、(平日) 学生課 (0532-44-6553) もしくは(夜間・休日の場合は) 大学の守衛所 (0532-44-6590) へ連絡してください。

※逃げ場に困った場合など、大学正門にある「守衛所」にまずは駆け込んでください。(24 時間対応)

(3) 不審な勧誘への注意

地下鉄サリン事件などの凶悪事件を起こしたオウム真理教は、学生向けの SNS やサークル等を装い、名前を隠して若者を勧誘するなど、現在も活動を続けています。以下は彼らの特徴です。

- ・今は「Aleph」「ひかりの輪」と名のっています。
- ・勧誘するときは本当の名前を言いません。
- ・ヨガ教室や悩み事の相談だと言って近づきます。

また、上記団体以外にも様々な勧誘活動がありますので、怪しい誘いには断る勇気を持ってください。

(4) 交通ルールの遵守

夏に免許を取得する人も多くいますが、交通マナーを守り、安全運転に努めてください。加害者も被害者も不幸になります。特に信号のない交差点や見通しの悪い道路などは、注意して運転してください。

夏休みを楽しく過ごすためにも、社会のルールを守り、自分の身は自分で守る安全な生活を心掛けてください。

Please be reminded of the following cautions during the summer vacations

(1) Prevention of accidents during leisure time

The water accidents during leisure time have already occurred all over Japan this year too, and there are many cases, which not only the person, but also those who try to rescue them become victim. Because last year, many accidents, which there have been life-threatening accidents involving students of TUT, occurred, more careful actions are required.

When you enjoy leisure activities in sea, rivers and mountains...

1 . please be aware of natural threats and protect yourself by judging the situation carefully.

2 . Before planning and carrying out actions, please gather information on the location and do a preparation and safety check in advance.

3 . Be aware that Enshu Sea Coast, 110km stretch from Omaezaki in Enshu, Shizuoka Prefecture to Irigo Cape in Higashimikawa, Aichi Prefecture, has many dangerous areas with strong current and sudden deepening water, so swimming is prohibited in almost place. Please be careful even at the shore.

(2) To prevent victimization from all forms of crimes

Avoiding involvement in crimes, you should...

1 . Passing through busy, well-lit streets

(Dark and deserted streets likely increase crime incidences)

2 . Avoiding going out late at night

(The possibility of getting involved in crimes is high during the night)

3 . Always lock the front door and balcony sash.

(For preventing people break in your house)

If you encounter a suspicious person, contact the Student Affairs Division (0532-44-6553) (on weekdays) or the TUT security office (0532-44-6590) (at night or on weekends) immediately.

※If you have trouble finding a place to escape, please run to the guard station at the university's main gate. (24-hour support)

(3) To be aware of suspicious solicitation from the cult and other suspicious organizations

For example, Aum Shinrikyō; the cult, which caused the sarin gas attack on the subway and other heinous incidents, is still active today, and they are recruiting young people under the guise of social networking sites for students, clubs, etc., under concealed their name.

The description of their traits...

1 . They now call themselves “Aleph” and “Hikari no Wa.”

2 . They don't say their real name when they solicit.

3 . They would approach you to invite to a yoga class or getting advices on their problems

Moreover, there are various recruiting activities by the other suspicious organizations such as the cult besides Aum Shinrikyō, so you need to pay close attention to them.

(4) To obey traffic rules.

Some students, who have a driver's license, may drive a car during summer vacations

as well. You should drive safely and must obey traffic manners for avoiding traffic car accident. Especially, when you drive at intersections with no traffic lights and roads with poor visibility, you need to pay extra attention to your drive.

Please read carefully above and follow the rules of Japanese society for being able to enjoy your summer vacation!
