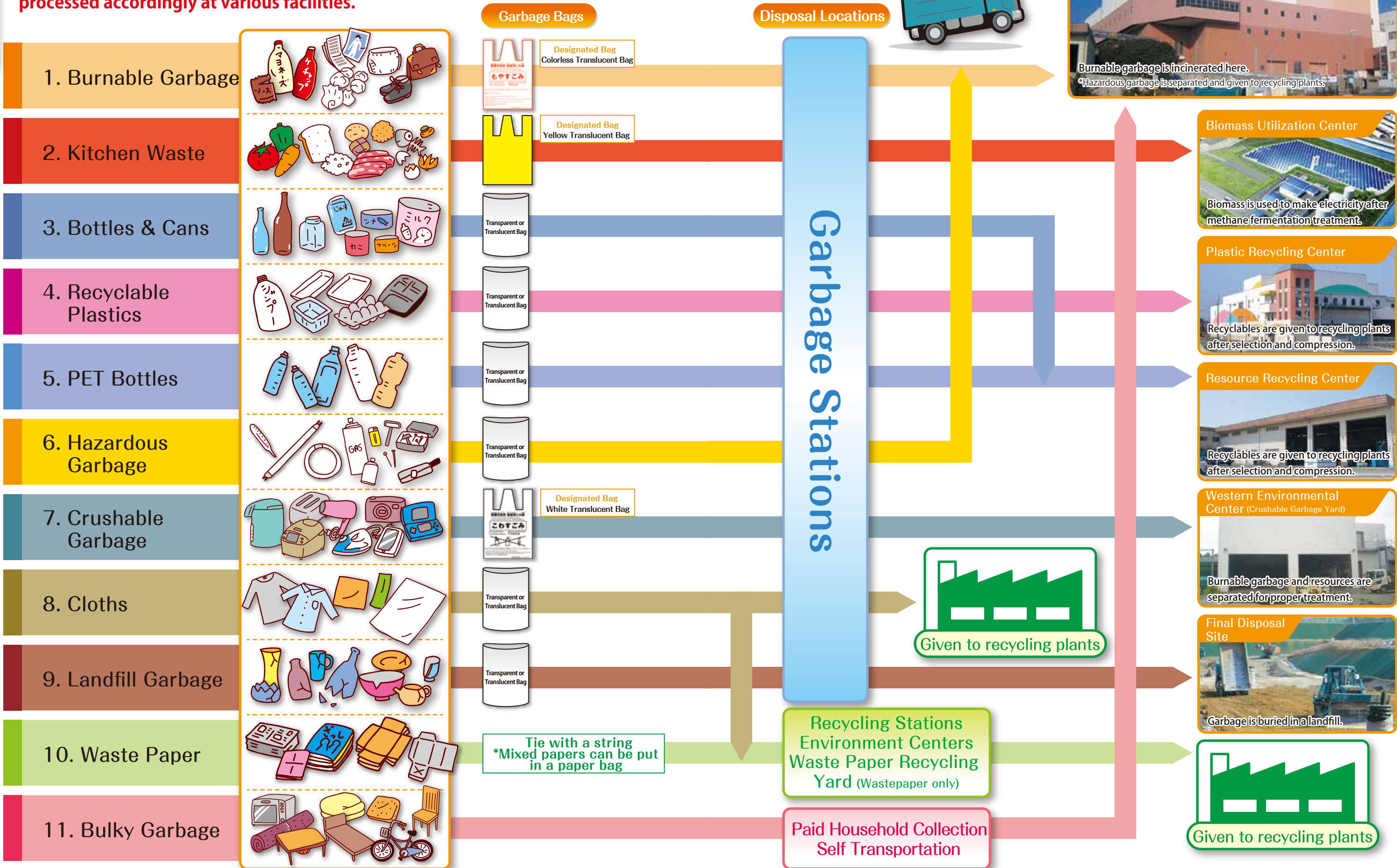

Garbage which you have sorted and disposed of will be collected by type and processed accordingly at various facilities.

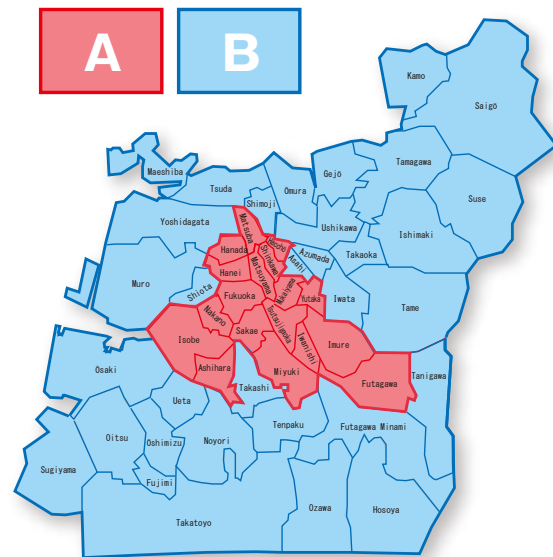

- "A Districts" are districts where garbage is collected on Mondays and Thursdays, while "B Districts" are districts where garbage is collected on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Collection of Bottles & Cans

From April 2017, bottles and cans will be collected from garbage stations, not bottle and can boxes.

Why change collection to garbage stations?

While bottle and can boxes are convenient, they bring a range of problems. In addition to inappropriate waste other than bottles and cans being disposed of, there have been noises, odors, and pests due to bottles and cans being disposed of at night. High costs are incurred to maintain and manage bottle and can boxes, so the city has decided to change to garbage stations.

What will be done with the removed boxes?

Removed boxes will be given to residents' associations and schools that ask for them, and used for local resource collection.

Why start sorting of kitchen waste?

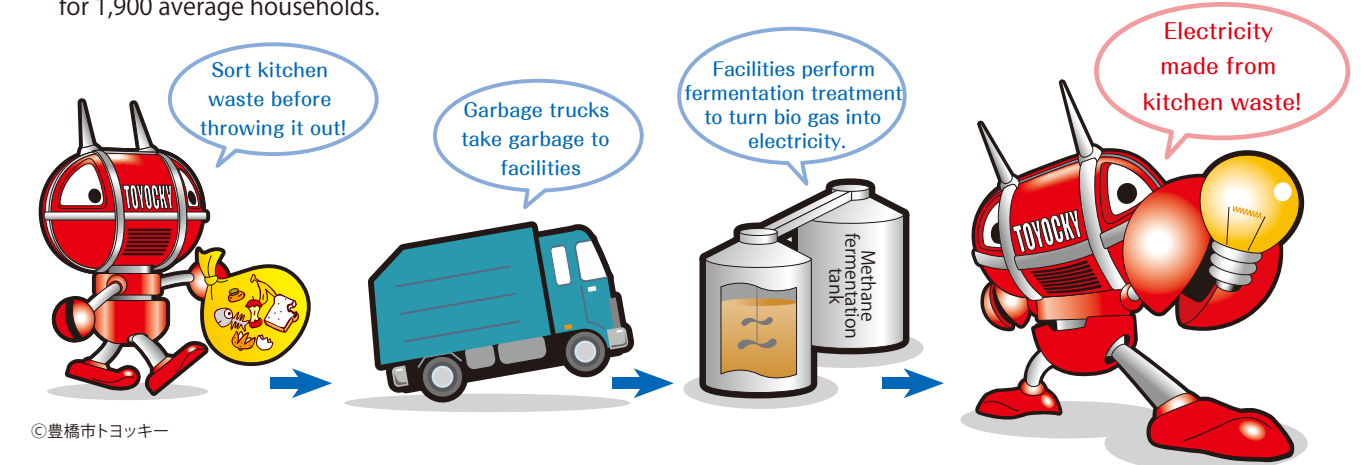
To recycle as resources the "kitchen waste", which is currently collected and incinerated as burnable garbage.

What will be done with kitchen waste after it is collected as a resource?

Collected garbage will be subject to methane fermentation along with sewage, excrement, and septic tank waste at the "Biomass Utilization Center".

What happens after methane fermentation treatment?

Methane fermentation generates bio gas. This bio gas is used to generate electricity. It is expected to generate electricity for 1,900 average households.

How to dispose of garbage at garbage stations

Please follow these rules and manners for taking out and sorting garbage.

- Bring garbage on the set days. ● Bring garbage between dawn and 8:30 AM on garbage collection days.
- Bring garbage to garbage stations on the set days for your area.
- Bring burnable garbage, crushable garbage, and kitchen waste in their specified bags.
- Bring bottles and cans, recyclable plastics, PET bottles, hazardous garbage, cloths, and landfill garbage in translucent or transparent bags.
- **Garbage stations are for household garbage only.**
Business garbage produced as a byproduct of business activities may not be disposed of at garbage stations.

When disposing of hazardous garbage...

- Hazardous garbage can cause fires in garbage trucks or cause injury to garbage collectors. Do not mix it with other types of garbage.
- Put digital thermometer and "mercury-free" labeled batteries in crushable garbage. Bring rechargeable batteries back to the retailer.
- Return syringes to hospital pharmacies. (If unable to return them, put them in a sealed container and clearly label the contents before disposal.)
- Do not poke holes in spray cans.
- Wrap blades in paper or the like.
- Put needles, nails, razors and the like in sealed containers and clearly label the contents before disposal.

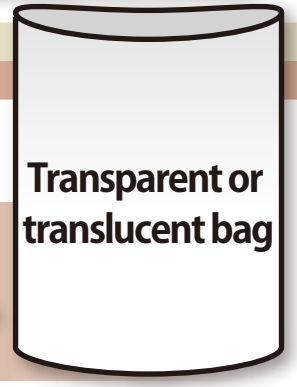

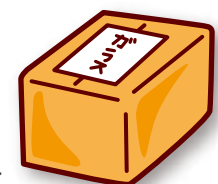

- When disposing of broken glass, clearly label the contents and put it in a cardboard box.
- Cardboard boxes can easily break in the rain, so place the whole cardboard box in a bag.
- Dispose of glass products which cannot be separated from non-glass parts as crushable garbage.

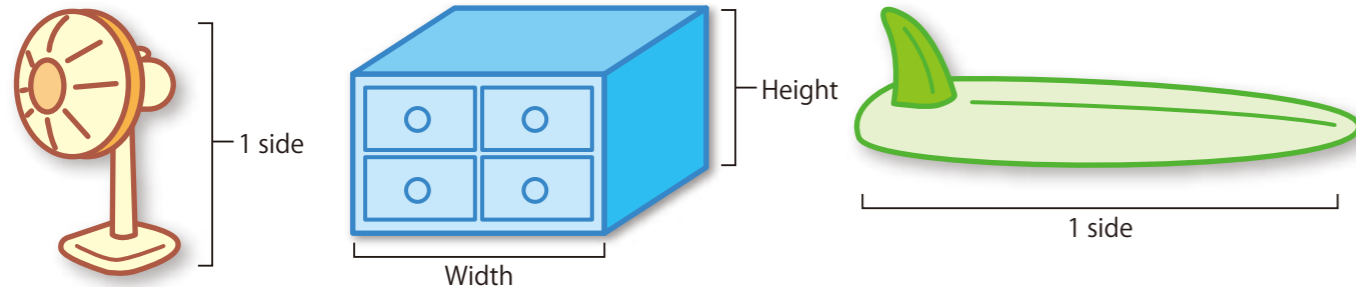

2. Inform the Center of your address, name, telephone number, and the type of bulky garbage, as well as the size and quantity.

<Up to 5 items can be collected at once>



3. The Reception Center will notify you of your receipt number, the collection date, where to put your bulky garbage, and handling fees by item.

4. Buy a bulky garbage certificate (seal) equivalent in value to the handling fee from a bulky garbage certificate vendor.

- Write your name and receipt number on the certificate.
- Place the certificate on an easily visible part of the bulky garbage.
- Certificates are sold at supermarkets, convenience stores, and other retailers bearing this seal.
- Buy your certificate after calling the Reception Center and confirming the fees.
- Pay recycling fees for the 4 special appliances separately at a post office.

5. Disposing of bulky garbage

- Bring the bulky garbage to the location specified by the Reception Center by 8:30 AM on the collection date.
- You must be present when disposing of the 4 special appliances. Have your paid recycling ticket ready at that time.

- Reservations by telephone (TEL: 46-5304) are accepted from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM except for on weekends, holidays, and New Year's. Please tell your address (town name), full name, telephone number, and all the items and times that you will deliver items.

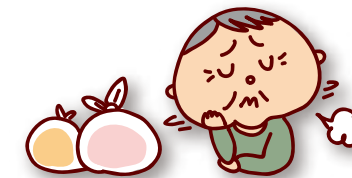

Business operators must take responsibility for properly disposing of business garbage (garbage produced by business activity). Even small quantities of business garbage may not be brought to local garbage stations or delivered to city facilities.

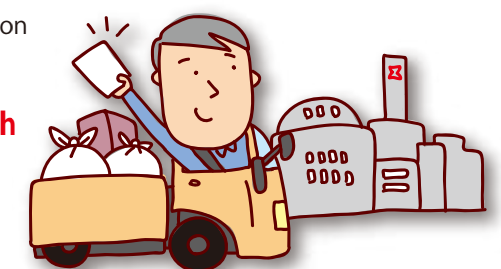
In particular, in the case of stores adjoined to households, be careful not to mix business garbage with household garbage.

To dispose of business garbage, either commission disposal to a private waste disposal operator, or after obtaining disposal permission at the Waste Management Section, deliver garbage to the Resource Recovery Center (Kitchen waste can also be brought to the Biomass Reuse Center).

Recyclable waste paper can also be taken to the Waste Paper Recycling Yard (page 14).

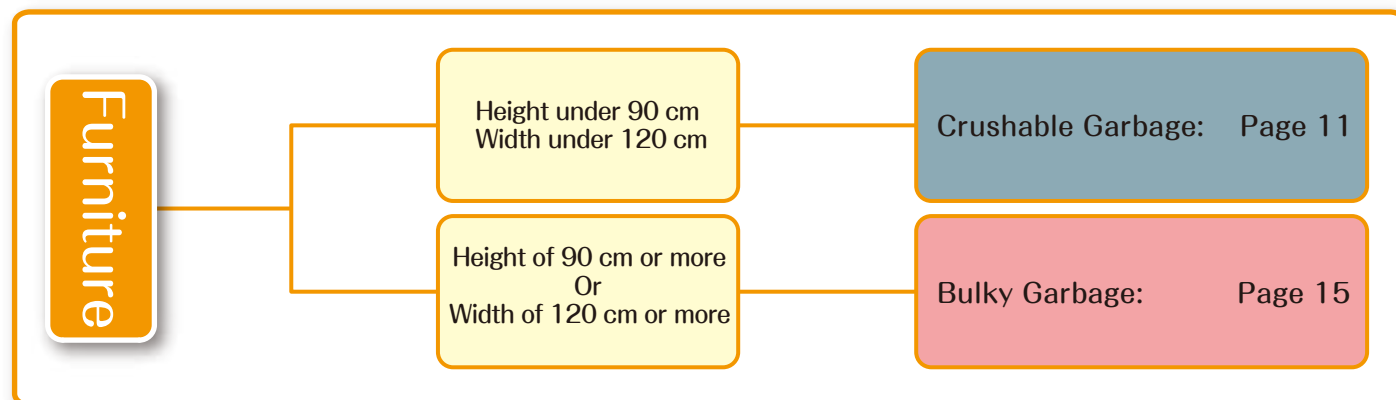
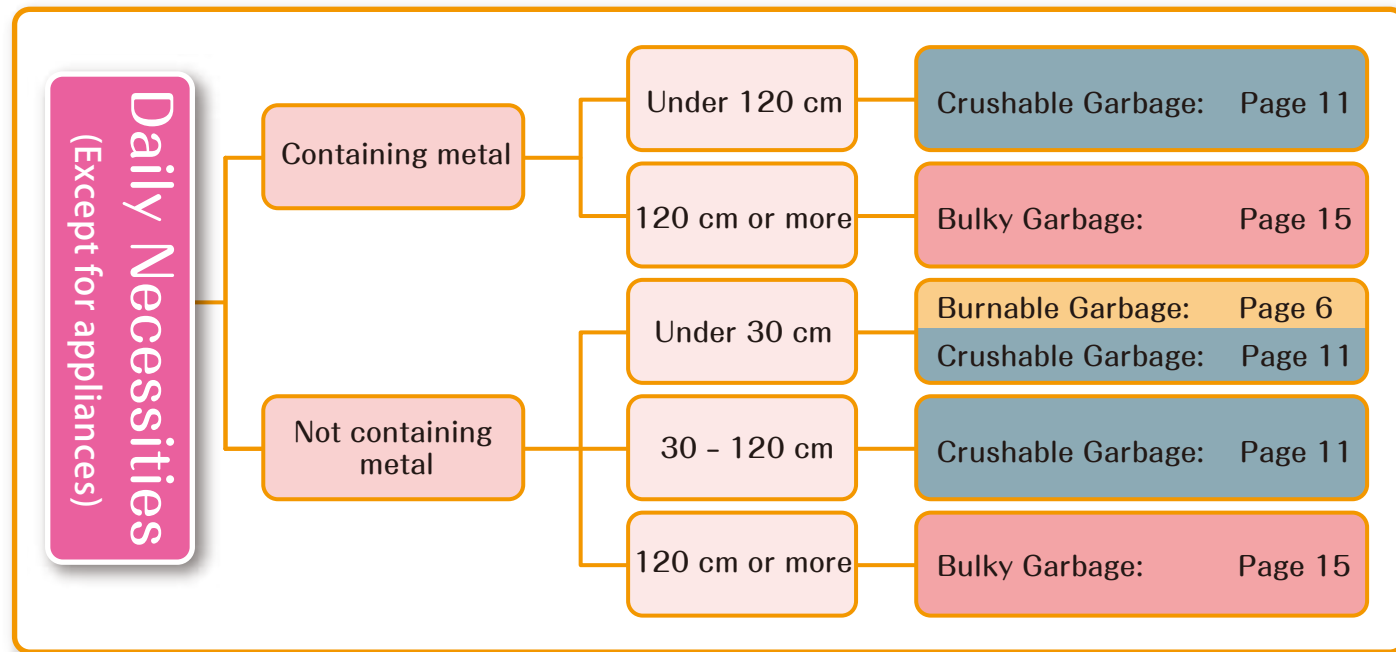
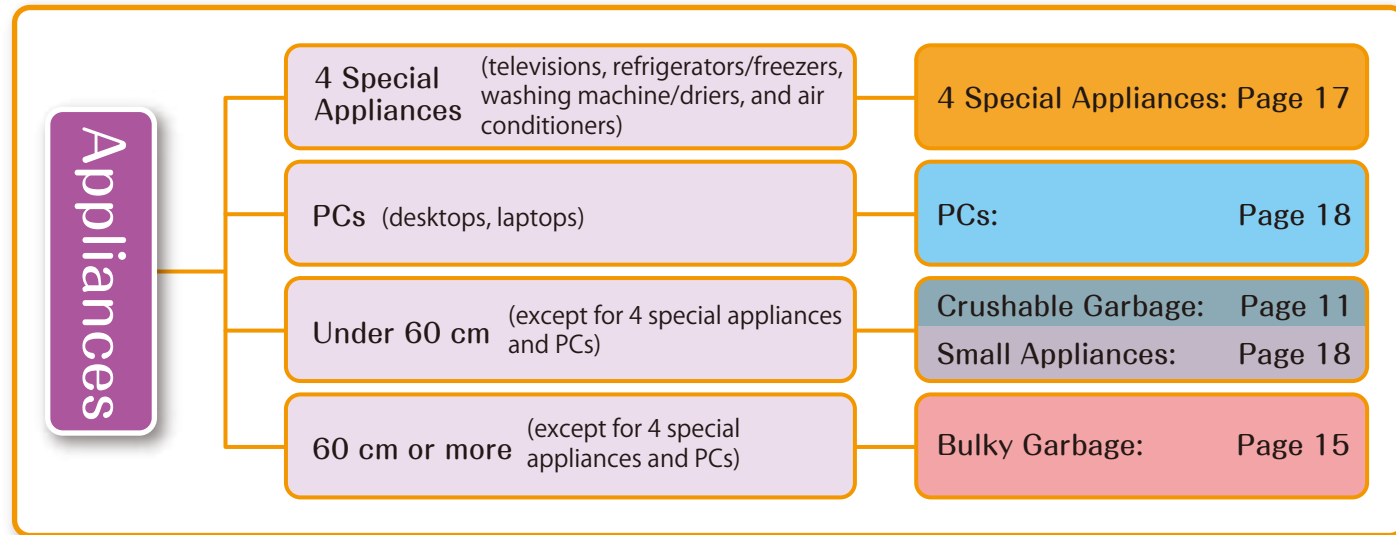
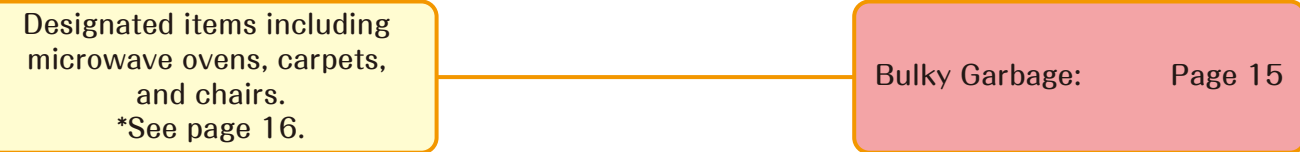

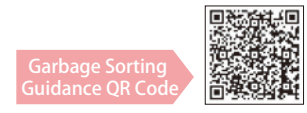


Sorting Flow Chart

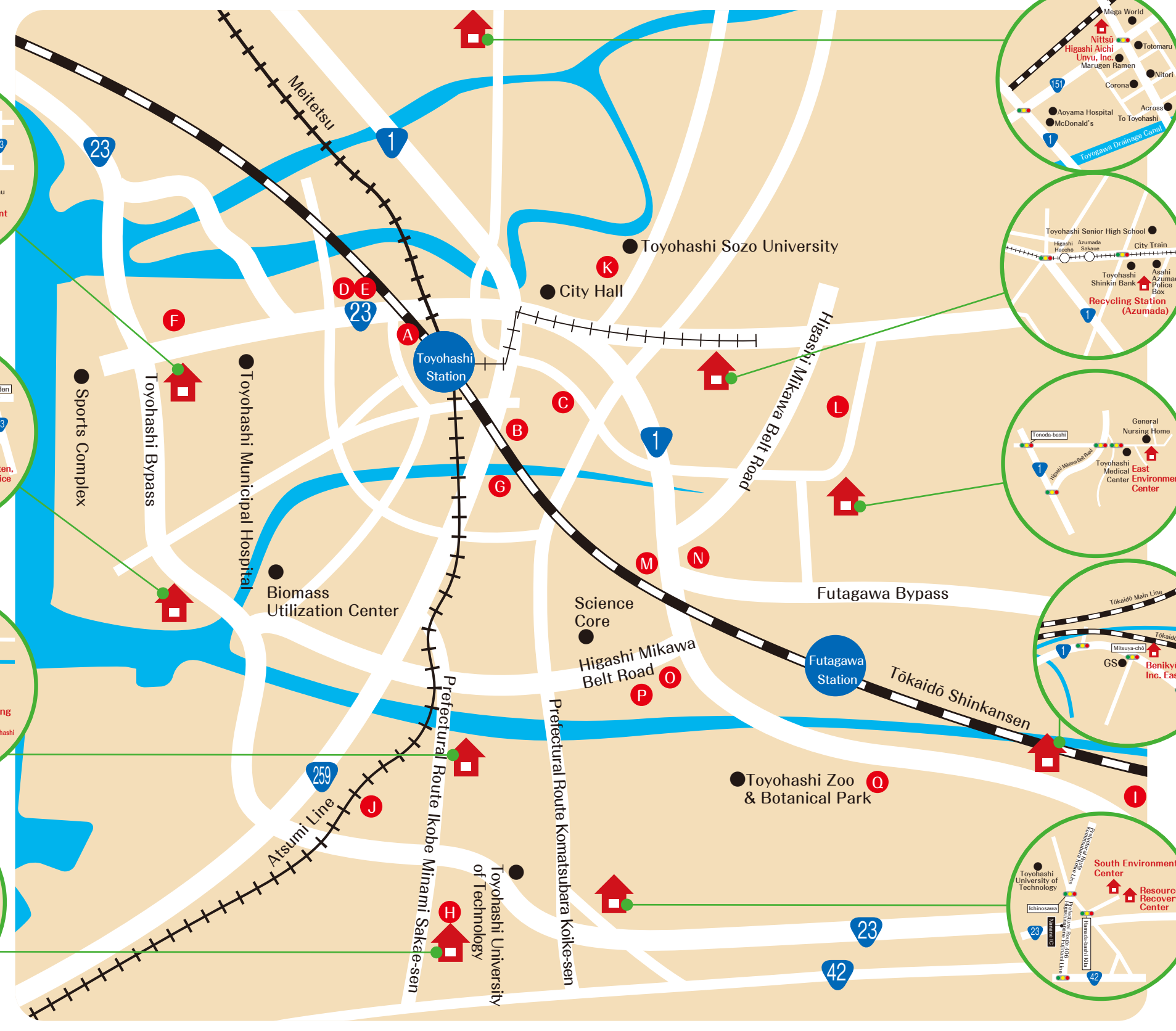
