

**【Eligibility for International House】**

International House at Toyohashi University of Technology (TUT) is a dormitory for new international students coming to Japan.

However, due to the limited number of rooms (40 single rooms, 6 couple rooms, and 10 family rooms), priority is given according to the study abroad program to which the international student belongs.

Mainly, short-term students under inter-university exchange agreements, double degrees, and twinning programs are eligible to apply. but other international students who are newly enrolled at TUT also may be eligible to if there are rooms available,

The length of stay would depend on the program to which the international student belongs, it is generally within 6 months. However, for short-term international students, double degree program and twinning program students, it covers the period of the end of the program (it's generally one year).

- ◆ Application period (for April enrollment) : By February
- (for October enrollment) : By August

\*Even if you move in in the middle of the semester and in the duration of the period of residence, you may be required to move out at the end of the semester, March or September, because period of residence for International House generally can't extend one semester. However, this does not apply for short-term students, double degree and twinning students.

**【The procedure of applying for TUT International House】**

1. If you are eligible to apply for TUT International House, please contact International Student Section, Student Affairs Division ([ryugaku@office.tut.ac.jp](mailto:ryugaku@office.tut.ac.jp)) at least one month prior to moving in, with your name, nationality, academic course and department you are enrolled, and the period of enrollment at TUT.
2. If you are approved to move in, please fill out "Application for International House" which will be sent from TUT, and send it back to the university by email. (Please submit the original form as well when you come to TUT.)  
If your application has been denied, you will be notified by the university.
3. If you are approved, you will receive a room key and an "Approval of Admission" from International Student Section on the day you move in, and also be required to pay the residence fee for International House, so please have it ready in cash with the exact amount, referring to GUIDE BOOK of International House.
